Covid Testing

We would like to remind parents about the government guidance regarding testing for Covid. There are two tests available to check if you have got Covid:

A PCR Test (for people who are displaying symptoms)

Get a PCR test as soon as possible if you have any of the following symptoms – a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste. If someone in your household develops Covid symptoms, you should all isolate at home until you get a negative test result. During this time, the children in the household should not attend school. PCR tests are mainly used to confirm coronavirus cases in people with symptoms who are already self-isolating. They can still find positive cases even if someone has stopped being infectious.

A Rapid Lateral Flow Test (only for people who have no symptoms)

Around 1 in 3 people with COVID do not have symptoms but can still infect others. Rapid lateral flow tests help to find these cases. If someone can no longer infect others, rapid lateral flow tests are less likely to return a positive result.

Little Owls




