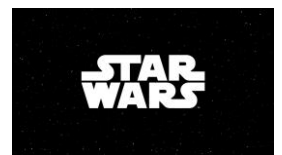

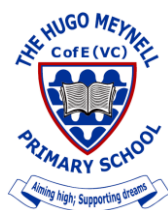


Little Owls
